

Seeking Assisted Outpatient Treatment Voices: Lived Experience & Natural Supports

AOT is a complex initiative that is being implemented in different ways with various outcomes across Michigan and the United States.

Our role with AOT involves creating a comprehensive report on the state of AOT in Michigan—what is working, what isn't, and what needs attention. To ensure our findings accurately represent AOT in our state, we are reaching out to everyone involved: individuals at courts, community mental health agencies, and those with first-hand experience whether you have personally been on an AOT order or have served as a natural support for someone on an AOT order.







What is it?

A virtual survey capturing both lived experience and natural support perspectives of being on an AOT order in Michigan.



Who are we looking for?

Individuals who have personally been on an AOT order in Michigan (currently or within the last five years) or who have provided natural support to someone on an AOT order.



What is involved?

The online survey consists of 23 questions and will take approximately 10-15 minutes to complete. Participation in this survey is entirely voluntary, and you may stop at any time without any consequences. All responses will be entirely anonymous, ensuring your privacy is fully protected.
