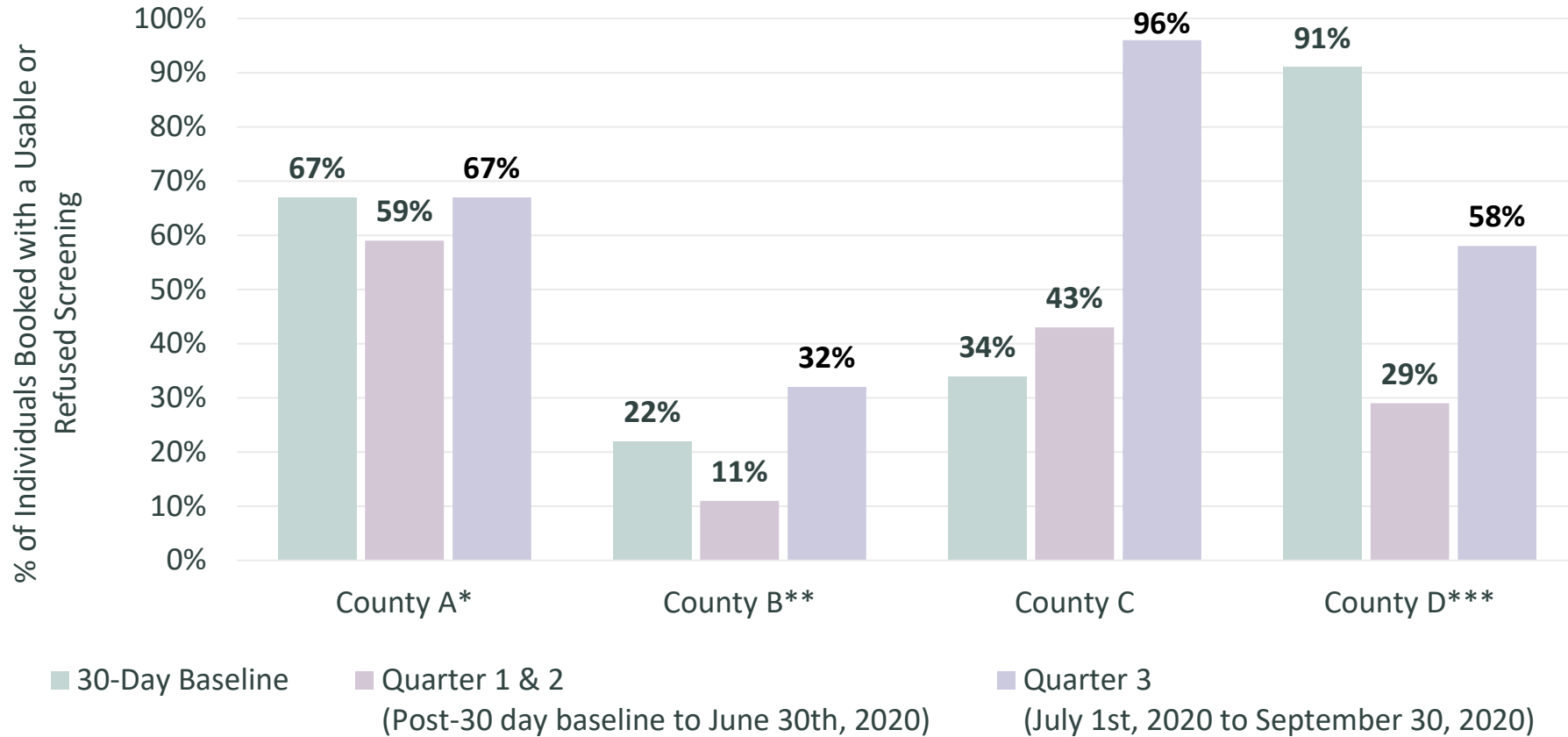

Individuals Screened by Rapid Opioid Dependence Screens (RODS)



- Between 22% and 91% of individuals booked into 4 jails were screened during the RODS 30-day baseline period.
- During Quarter 1 and 2, 11% to 59% were screened. Over the course of Quarter 3, 32% to 96% were screened.
- County A has maintained its screening rate over time; County B and C increased their rate; County D rates decreased during Quarter 1 & 2 but have since rose.

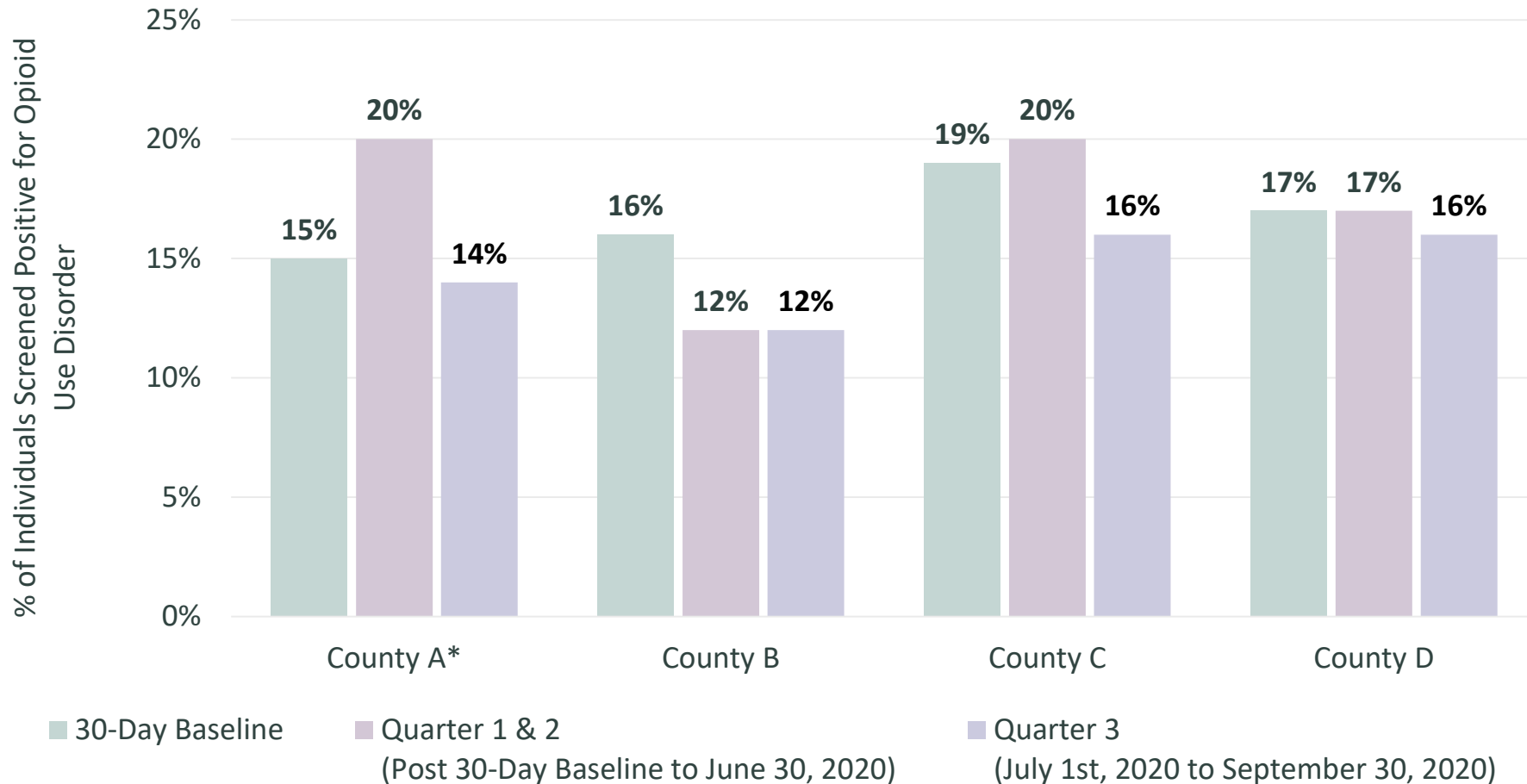
Includes 'Usable' and 'Refused' screenings; Usable screens were successfully administered to individuals booked into the jail and scored; Refused screens were offered to but refused by individuals.

*Due to staff turnover at the site during November/December, some RODS may not have been submitted for analysis during this time period but it is unknown how many RODS are not accounted for.

** Missing data from January and February 2020.

*** RODS administration was suspended at this site from 3/13/20 to 4/2/20 due to COVID-19. Proportion with a usable or refused screen increased from prior presentations for the Quarter 1 & 2 time period due to clarity in data collection practices.

Individuals Screened Positive for Risk of Opioid Use Disorder (OUD)



- Across four jails, risk of OUD ranged from:
 - 15% to 19% during the 30-day baseline period
 - 12% to 20% during Quarter 1 & 2
 - 12% to 16% during Quarter 3
- In County A, a significantly smaller percentage of people screened positive in Quarter 3 (14%) than in Quarter 1 & 2 (20%).

Data Source: 2019 30-Day Baseline, 2019-2020 Quarter 1 & 2, 2020 Quarter 3 RODS (n=8,204)

A screen is considered positive if the person reported heroin or other opioid use in the past year, use of medications for opioid use disorder (buprenorphine or methadone) in the past year, or current use of medications for opioid use disorder (buprenorphine, methadone, naltrexone).

* Difference is statistically significant
